NOTIFICATION

S.O. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of the section 11 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956(102 of 1956), the Central Government, after consulting the Medical Council of India, hereby makes the following further amendments in the First Schedule to the said Act, namely:-

In the said First Schedule against "Maharishi Markandeshwar University, Maullana (Ambala)" under the heading 'Recognized Medical Qualification' [in column (2)] and under the heading 'Abbreviation for Registration' [in column (3)], the following shall be inserted, namely:-

Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery	M.B.B.S. (This shall be a recognized medical qualification when granted by Maharishi Markandeshwar University, Maullana (Ambala) in respect of students being trained at M.M. Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Muallana (Ambala) in respect of 150 students per year admitted from the academic year 2007 onwards.
